Milton, FL – The Tobacco Free Santa Rosa Coalition will host the *Sustaining Our Future Workshop* from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 26, in the main conference room of the Florida Department of Health in Santa Rosa County, 5527 Stewart Street in Milton. The workshop will bring together coalition members, community partners, small business owners and human resource managers to discuss electronic nicotine delivery systems, smoke-free multi-unit housing, smoking cessation and optimizing employee health.
